For Study Investigating Neuropathic Pain in Spinal Cord Injury

A PhD research project is looking for adult volunteers to participate in a research study using electroencephalography (EEG).

The project requires healthy volunteers to take part in the same experiment that will also be performed with spinal cord injured patients. EEG is a noninvasive method of recording the electrical activity of your brain. During the session we will record your EEG whilst asking you to imagine performing some movements.
